Home to school bus service – January Update

Here we are again. With schools closed we have been operating our Key Worker Bus Service to each of the schools where we operate Home to School Transport.

We are again requesting that parents continue to make their regular payments in line with the contract they agreed at the start of the year. Monthly payments should continue as scheduled. Where parents chose to pay in advance the February Payment is still to be paid by the 1st February as per your agreement. This must be paid on time to be eligible for the advance payment discount.

Parents who are Key Workers and have no alternative options available can still use the Key Worker service to take their children to school. However they must pre-book with at least 1 working days prior notice. This you can do by confirming the child's name, pick up point and days required by Text to the emergency number on the back of your travel pass. We will then send a Text Message to confirm pick up details. Please note the times and pick up points may be different to the normal ones.

At this stage we do not know how long the special arrangements will be required. As schools reopen to full year groups the normal service will resume. Until then we will only take passengers who have no other viable option and who's parents are essential Key Workers. Please do not request the service unless you have no alternative option. We need to protect our drivers and school staff. Putting a child on the bus should be a last resort as it is a potential point of contact between pupils and drivers which we are trying to keep to a minimum. The safety of everyone is our main concern.

We will, near the end of this academic year, be able to look at what savings can be passed back to parents as a result of not running all the vehicles on the school runs. Similarly, to how we did this for the last academic year. We will try to offer refunds/discounts which will be calculated once we know how long schools are closed.

Currently we have at least 1 vehicle operating to each school available to Bus Club Members who need it.

We hope normal services can resume as soon as possible and ask parents to advise all passengers that they must wear a face covering and use the Sanitizer gel provided whenever they get on or off the bus.

For now please stay at home, protect the NHS and Save Lives.

This is far more serious than the first wave and we want all our drivers and passengers to survive for when the lock down restrictions are removed. Till we can all be together again.
